### **Planning applications**

DC/21/1170 Erection of a two-storey side extension and repositioning of boundary fence to incorporate land to side and rear of the dwelling within residential curtilage - 12 Mill Mead  
The Parish Council are concerned at the movement of the fence as it would have an adverse impact on the street scene. In many parts of Ashington developers left green space between roads and residents' fences; sometimes this space is the equivalent of a footpath sometimes just green space. The norm for Mill Mead would seem to be to have the equivalent of a footpath width of green between the road and the fences. This is what the PC believes should be retained here; especially as the fence will be close boarded to 1.8m. This would allow for the fence to be moved out towards the road, but not as far as requested. It would still allow for the extension to be done. Otherwise, the Parish Council has no objections.
