DC/19/1966 Surgery to 1 x Oak – Ashington Rectory, Mill Lane

The Council is concerned that the proposed works will affect the longevity of the tree. Removal of the tree top and shaping into a 'wine glass' shape is inappropriate for an oak tree and could shorten its life. The Council has no problems with the proposed removal of lower branches i.e. crown lifting. Any works should be done to minimise any chance of premature tree death and be carried out by a qualified arboriculturalist.
