Planning applications

DC/13/1228 Removal of external stair and commercial extract flue and installation of Juliette balconies (Listed Building Consent) – Mill House Hotel, Mill Lane. The Council has no objections.

DC/13/1211 Installation of new mechanical plant in the rear service yard – Co-op. The Council has no objections as long as the new mechanical plant is no noisier than existing plant.

The Clerk had presented Councillors with a copy of a letter from a member of the public to HDC regarding this application. The letter asked HDC to consider delivery restrictions to the store (times and size of vehicles) as current deliveries are causing severe disruption to local residents. Parish Councillors did acknowledge that this is an issue that HDC should know about but that it was not relevant to this particular planning application.
