Planning applications

WSCC/051/11/AS & DC/11/1618 Ashington WTW, Hole Street - Construction of a walk-in Ferric Dosing Kiosk and Effluent Monitoring Kiosk to support wastewater treatment works upgrades.

The Council have no objections but ask that a planning condition be made such that construction traffic enter and leave site via the A24 Hole Street junction only. Construction vehicles passing through the village along London Road (over the speed humps) would cause significant disturbance to local residents.

Cllr Wood left the room.

DC/11/1557 Installation of 8 solar photovoltaic panels on garage flat roof - 19 Fairfield Road. The Council have no objections.

Cllr Wood returned to the room.

DC/11/1562 Front open porch - 5 Posthorses. The Council have no objections.

DC/11/1595 Prior notification for erection of a wooden barn timber clad with a tiled roof - Mitchbourne Farm Malthouse Lane. The Council are not required to comment on this application.
