Planning applications

DC/14/1371 Demolition of existing garage and erection of replacement garage, alterations to existing stable block to form new glazed roof, new 2.1m high fence and entrance gates to front boundary with Billingshurst Road – Foxes, Billingshurst Road

The Parish Council object to the application on the grounds of poor appearance in the street scene as a result of the proposed 2.1m high close boarded fence and 2.3m high gates along Billingshurst Road (a country road). The street scene currently benefits from good views of the property through vegetation and picket fence and this will be totally lost behind the new high fence. Other properties along Billingshurst Road have open frontages. The Council considers that the description of works is not entirely accurate as the stable block appears to be fully converted to garages rather than be 'altered to form a new glazed roof'.
