#### **TERMS OF REFERENCE**

##### **Purpose of Community Partnership Group**

The purpose of the Community Partnership Group is to be a local grassroots 'sounding board' for the Chanctonbury Churches Youth Worker as they develop & deliver youth provision.

##### **Group members will be:**

- Rector
- Youth Worker (where necessary)
- 2 x Ashington Parish Councillors
- Ashington Parish Council Clerk
- 2 x Neighbourhood Wardens
- 1 x Ashington Youth Club Management Committee
- Resident
- 2 x Youth Centre Young People

##### **Key Objectives**

- To support the development & delivery of local youth provision
- To increase the local community's understanding of the role of the Youth Worker
- To engage with the local community and organisations in relation to local youth provision
- To support best practice
- To share local information & needs relating to young people
- To act as a 'sounding board' to the Youth Worker
- To promote youth activities and needs (eg volunteers, equipment, venues) in the community

##### **Scope**

The Partnership Group is to meet every month for the first year of the project with additional meetings and events organised as required. The Youth Worker will develop themes for each meeting to enable discussions.

##### **Safeguarding**

Chanctonbury Churches who employ the Youth Worker have clear policies and procedures in place concerning: Child Protections, Diversity and Equal Opportunities, Health and Safety, Confidentiality, Reporting of Complaints/reporting of concerns or allegations of abuse, Recruitment/staffing/grievance and disciplinary.

##### **Roles and Responsibilities**

Both the Community and Chanctonbury Churches Partnership Groups exist to feed in, advise and shape local youth provision through the Rector. The project will be managed according to the aims of both groups.
