Planning applications

DC/17/1334 Malthouse Cottage Farm, Malthouse Lane
Proposed erection of garage with annexe above.

The plans were reviewed and discussed. Councillors objected as this is a residential development in the countryside. However, should the application be permitted it was requested that a condition be applied stating that the garage with annexe over cannot be sold or separated from the house.

DC/17/1474 Hoots House, London Road
Variation of condition 1 of DC/14/1999 (Demolition of existing building and erection of 2no. detached and 4no. semi-detached 2 storey houses). Minor material amendment to the external appearance and internal layout of the houses within the development. Various alterations to window positions and sizes, addition of tile hanging to northern elevation of plots 4 and 5, and change of materials of plot 6 to match those approved on plot 1

The plans were reviewed and discussed and all agreed to support the application as the amendments are improvements to the original plans.

Retrospective erection of side bin/log store to existing detached garage, erection of detached summer house and loft conversion
